The most well-known wreck in the Red Sea!

This tour takes you to the famous wrecks and reefs in the northern part of the Red Sea, and on top of that the interesting reefs in the Strait of Tiran.

First it goes to Sha'ab El Erg (Dolphin House), the wrecks of Abu Nuhas (Carnatic, Chrisoula K., Ghiannis D.) are also on the program. The next wreck on the "menu" speaks for itself: The Thistlegorm, one of the most famous wrecks in the Red Sea, with its motorcycles, trucks and off-lying locomotive.

You will reach then the Strait of Tiran with the beautiful dive sites at Jackson, Thomas and Gordon Reef. If permitted by the weather and current conditions, you will visit the Rosalie Moller, a wreck that sank in the same night as the Thistlegorm and lies in the middle of the Strait of Gubal. Also at the island of Gubal fascinating dives are planned.

Then it continues north towards Dahab. Popular diving spots are the „Canyon“, the „Islands“, „Oasis“, the „Bells“ and the „Golden Blocks“. The „Blue Hole“ diving spot, which is considered one of the most famous in the world, is particularly well known. As an exceptionally deep and low-current spot (110 m, outside 201 m), it is highly valued by apnoe and technical divers. The Blue Hole is a large hole in the reef roof of the coastal fringing reef, which drops vertically from 70

m to 110 m. It has a diameter of 50 to 65 m. The reason why the Blue Hole is considered the most dangerous dive site in the world is because of its connection to the open sea, which because of its shape is called „Arch“. It extends from the bottom of the Blue Hole up to a depth of 55 m. At its upper end it is only a few meters wide and approx. 26 m long. The reef also forms an almost vertical drop on the outer edge, which continues below the "exit" of the Blue Hole as a steep slope down to several hundred meters. Most dives are carried out along the outer steep drop of the reef. The „Bells“ dive site, which is located about 150 meters from the Blue Hole, usually serves as the entry point.

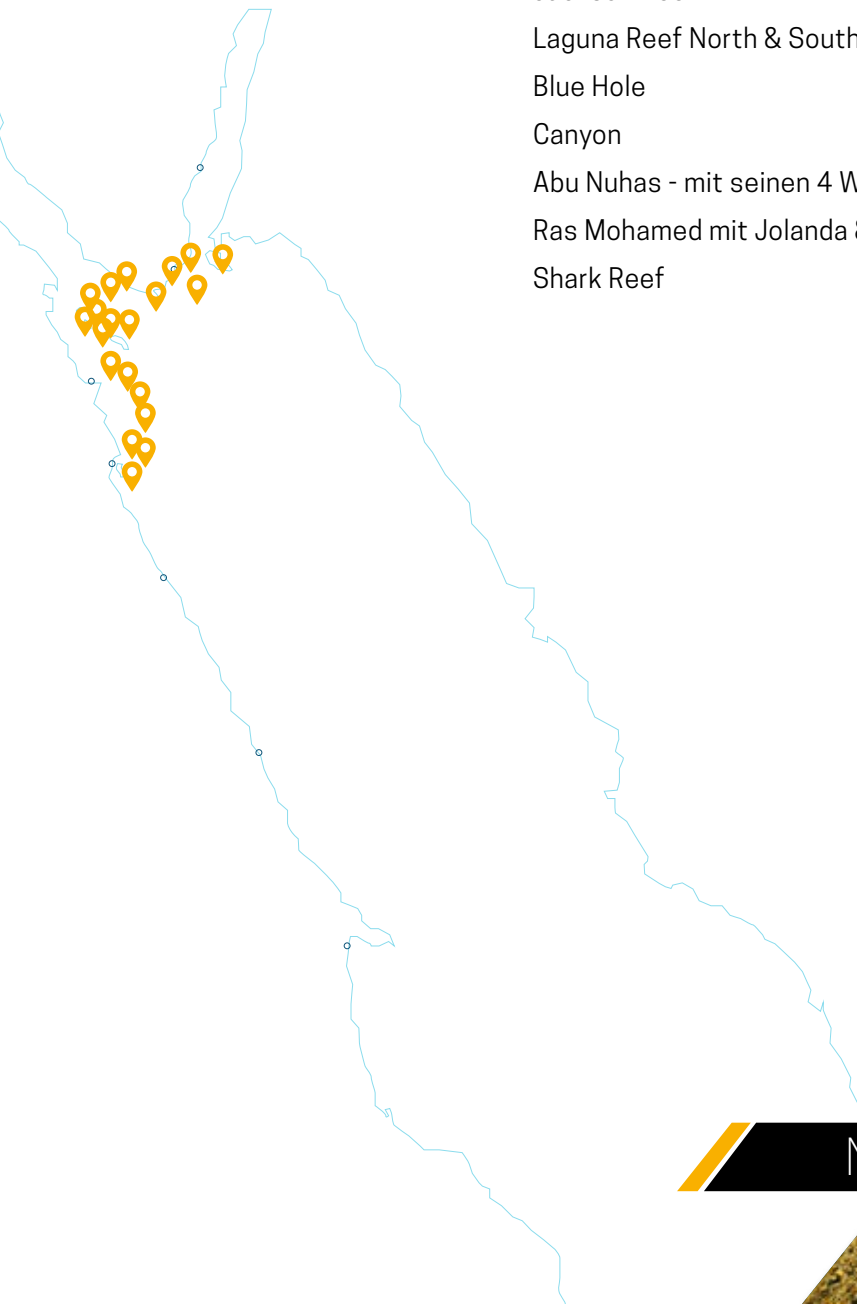
After arrival in Hurghada, transfer to the boat in Hurghada, dinner and departure the next morning.
